NEPTUN

- Before each semester you have to activate your student status and register for your subjects
- How to do it?
- Go to Neptun: <https://neptun11.uni-pannon.hu/hallgato/login.aspx>
- Follow these steps:
 - **Neptun -> Subjects -> Subject registration ->choose the correct semester -> select subject -> choose course -> save**
 - There are 2 registration periods for subjects:
 - **Preliminary** (usually in June and January) – you will get Neptun message
 - **Final** (on the registration week)

Exam registration

- Exam registration period: message will be sent by Neptun
- You can register for your exams in the exam registration period.
- When it starts, we will show you how to do it in a session.

Proposed grades

- Here you can view your proposed grades, which you can accept or reject. If a lecturer of a subject of yours propose a grade to you and you accept it, it means that the proposed grade will be your final grade from the subject concerned, you don't have to take exam of that subject, and once the proposed grade accepted, this option will be prohibited for you by the system. **YOU HAVE TO ACCEPT IT BEFORE THE EXAM PERIOD**, otherwise it will not be valid.
- If you are not satisfied with the proposed grade, you may select the option to reject it; in that case you have to register to the exam from that subject.

Thesis

- The Master's thesis should be the result of work that is independently conducted, and that represents **original research** and critical analysis
- The title of the chosen topic and the name of the supervisor should be submitted by the end of the 2nd semester: **30th of April** (download from the Institutes webpage)
- Submission deadline: **30th of April** in spring semester, **30th of November** in autumn semester.
- No extension is allowed!

2nd semester


- Formulate the topic
