The following activities are acknowledged as part of the scholarship:

- mentoring the learning process of international and PhD students,
- helping to prepare for the examination period and final exams,
- create and maintain learning circles,
- survey and evaluate the individual needs of the international/PhD students, to give them concrete solutions,
- participating in the life of the Department and/or Doctoral Program (administration, organisation, etc.).

Every international student and PhD student, with the active autumn semester (2021-2022,) can submit their applications, via e-mail, to the following addresses:

The submitted proposals will be evaluated by the Committee of the Faculty, based on the documents and the personal (online) interview.

The scholarship is provided by the *EFOP-3.4.3-16-2016-00009 project*.

Deadline: 31 August, 2021

Personal (online) interview: 2 September, 2021

The amount of the scholarship: 30.000 Ft/Month/Student, for September, October, November, December, 2021. The winning applicants have to submit their reports on their activities every month.

Every applicant should fill in an application form and send it back with a motivational letter describing their intentions, goals, as well. After the deadline, we arrange online meetings to decide the ranking and decision. The principles of the evaluation are as follows:

- GDP/capita of the origin country to measure the degree of the needed support (data is available on the homepage of the World Bank),
- an average of the grades in the last two semesters,
- a motivational letter, and
- a personal interview.

The last two aspects assessed based on the communicational skills and commitment.
